



Loan Appeal Process

If your application has been submitted to Beaver River CFDC and all information requested has been provided to Beaver River CFDC and loan has been declined, you are entitled to appeal the decision.

To appeal your decision, please submit a signed letter of request within 30 days from decline date to the Beaver River CFDC Investment Committee that you wish to appeal the decline decision. Please include your reasons and any supporting documentation or evidence as to why you believe this decision should be changed to an approval. If the Investment Committee also declines your application, and you are in disagreement with this decision, you may request that the Provincial Appeals Committee for Saskatchewan Community Futures review your application.

If you decide to request a review by the Provincial Appeals Committee, you must submit a letter within 10 days to the Chairperson of Beaver River CFDC. This letter must request that all information in regard to your application (including any financials, business plans, searches, etc.) be forwarded to the Provincial Appeals Committee, as well as the reason why your application was declined by Beaver River CFDC. The Provincial Appeals Committee will review all information provided by Beaver River CFDC and will provide recommendations, however they have no authority to make an approval of a loan. A final decision will be made and provided to the applicant once recommendations are sent to Beaver River CFDC from the Provincial Appeals Committee.
